Year 3 and Year 4: 6:30pm - 7:15pm Year 5 and Year 6: 7.30 pm - 8:15pm



Megan Y2 made 10 progressions and Shivank Y6 made 11 progressions this week. Well done to you both!








Well done to our Y3 boys; **Shiv** for achieving his yellow stripe belt and **Reuben** for achieving his white belt in kickboxing!
