feels...**

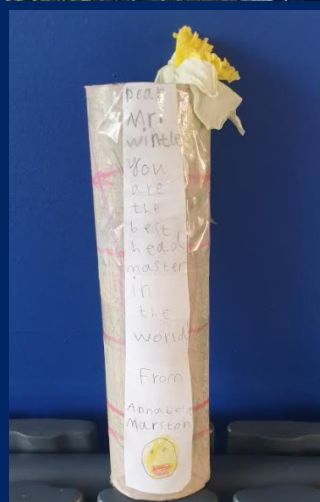

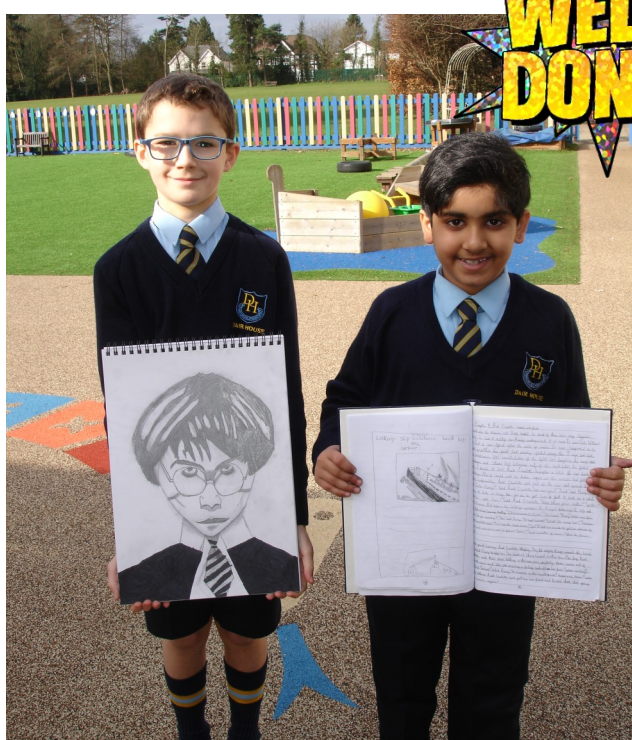
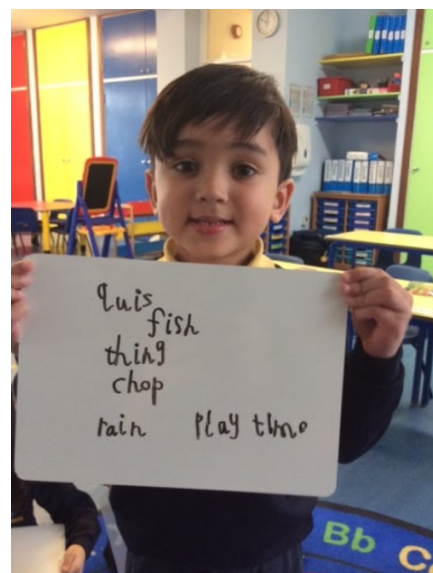
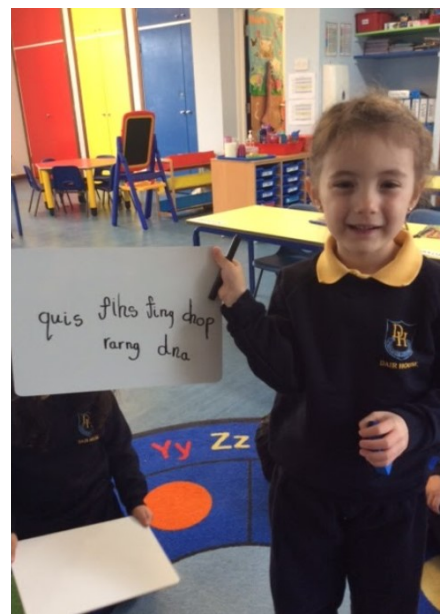
## Our Talented Children
