I called upon you to deliver golf clubs made of cardboard; turn dining room tables into cricket pitches; living rooms into gyms; gardens into playgrounds; and stairs into Mount Everest.

I needed you to visit the depths of your garages and dust off skateboards, bikes and scooters.

You had to endure my online 40 minute workouts and my taste in workout music at 100 decibels, no doubt causing lots of door shutting whilst you were zooming in important meetings!

You must have wondered what on earth was going to be asked of you next, with sellotape, cardboard and scissors at the ready!

Well done to St David, the House Cup winners from last term. They got to dress in yellow home clothes on Friday as a treat. They all look fantastic!














